We encourage your whole-hearted participation in nominating deserving individuals, for the George H. Seal Memorial Trophy. Department Commanders and Voluntary Service Program Managers should submit nominations to this office <u>no later than Friday,</u> <u>February 7, 2014</u>.

Department Commanders with more than one VA facility in their state may submit one DAV and one DAVA volunteer from each facility. You are encouraged to solicit recommendations and information from the VA medical facility Director, Service and Program Managers and other staff members directly involved with the VAVS program in your installation as well as from DAV VAVS Representatives and Deputies.
