Transportation between the hotels and airport

Taxis

All taxi companies in Las Vegas have lift-equipped vans accommodating one wheelchair. Ask taxi stand attendant in advance for an accessible taxi van.

- From the taxi stand, you can access a taxi. All taxis can take four people; provided all your luggage will fit.
- It should be about \$15 to Bally's/ Paris plus a tip.
- Long hauling (typically by going through the tunnel and taking the freeway) is a problem and can add \$5 to \$20 to the fare. Tell the taxi driver to <u>"take Paradise to the hotel, not</u> <u>the freeway"</u>).
- Be prepared to <u>have cash</u> for the taxi. Taxis who do accept credit cards will assess a \$3.00 processing fee.

Shuttles

Available outside the airport, shuttles consist of small buses that will drop at multiple hotels and are \$7 per person, plus tip. Speed depends on the number of hotels where the driver needs to stop. With Bally's/ Paris, you can probably expect a stop or two before you get there. Round trip tickets on the shuttle are not recommended, just to the hotel form the airport. Shuttles can take a long time, getting to the airport from multiple hotels, so a taxi is recommended.

Transportation while in Las Vegas

Strip Trolley

The trolley operates on the Las Vegas Strip and pulls up to the entrance of each hotel on its route. Most are lift-equipped. For details call (702) 382-1404.

CAT (Citizens Area Transit)

Bus service is fully accessible, including buses that are lift-equipped. Reduced fares are available for persons with disabilities. Call (702) 228-7433.

Paratransit

If you are certified to ride paratransit, bring your certification and you will be allowed to ride for up to 21 days without a Nevada certification. Call (702) 228-4800 one to three days in advance to schedule rides.
