- Departments and chapters must annually elect a commander, sr. vice commander, one or more jr. vice commanders and shall elect or appoint an adjutant and treasurer.
- Officer Reports submitted within 10 days.
- Changes throughout the year requires a new Officer Report.

- Nominating Committees have a purpose.

- Support is local, we must protect our image and brand.
- Trust but verify.
- Provide financial statements.
- Accountability – leaders and members.
 - D&O policy.
 - Reimbursement in accordance with Article 14, Section 14.9 and NEC Regulation 12.
 - Criminal and civil pursuit.



- Funding of DAV entities:
 - Chartered territory.
 - No online fundraising.
 - Fundraisers (golf tournaments, raffles, etc.)
 - Forget-Me-Not.
 - Membership dues distributions.
 - Department fundraising and sharing programs.
 - Wills and bequests.



- Bequest Reporting Program
 - Legal gifts.
 - Bequests and wills.
 - Mandatory reporting.
 - Legal and moral obligation.



- Appropriate expenditures of DAV funds.
- Provided to DAV for DAV programs.
 - Public expectation and our obligation.
 - No funding to other NPOs for general operations.
- Restricted vs. unrestricted.
 - What's the difference?
- All fundraising requests must specify the program or purpose for the activity.
