Bell Staff Bag Request: (Shuttle fees include round trip porterage fee from the hotel bell staff.)

If you plan to use the bell staff to take your bags to the departure area, you must make your request to the bell stand more than 45 minutes out from your scheduled departure time and your bags must have the green DAV band on them. Bands can be picked up from the shuttle desk. The bell staff will take bags with the green band to Wildwood 15. To ensure your bags are placed on the proper shuttle, you must retrieve your bags from Wildwood 15 and take them with you to your shuttle vehicle (the bell staff will not load bags directly to the shuttle vehicle).







Floor Plan






