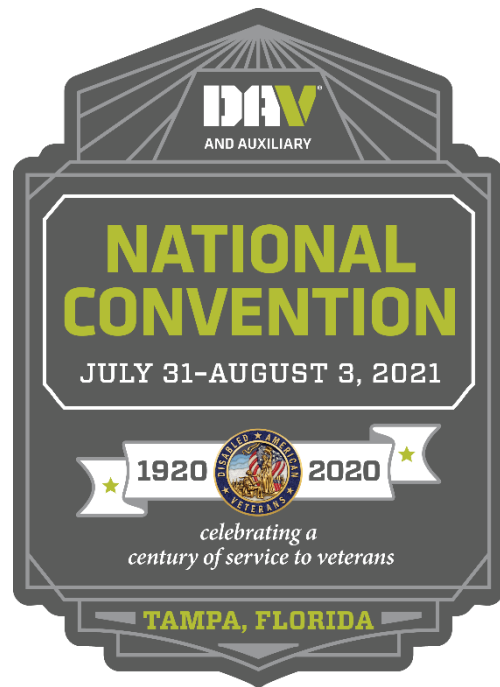


# DAV's Annual National Convention- Celebrating a century of Service to Veterans!
