

## Public Law 116-127, 2<sup>nd</sup> COVID-19 response bill was enacted on March 18th

✓ VA was provided \$60 million to help cover Coronavirus testing and treatment costs.

✓ Public Law 116-136, 3<sup>rd</sup> COVID-19 response bill (CARES Act) was enacted on March 27th

Nearly \$20 billion for VA.

1. P.L. 116-123, Coronavirus
Preparedness and Response
Supplemental Appropriations
Act, 2020





2. P.L. 116-127, Families First Coronavirus Response Act, March 18th

- ✓ VA Appropriations: \$60 million
- ✓ General VA Provision: No COVID-19 testing copayments



3. P.L. 116-136, Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act or the CARES Act:

- ✓ VA Appropriations: \$19.57 Billion
- ✓ General VA Provision: 14 provisions



### 3. CARES Act for VA COVID-19 response:

- ✓ \$15.1 billion for VA medical care
- ✓ \$2.1 billion for VA community care



### 3. CARES Act for VA COVID-19 response:

✓ For Veteran Directed Care program, temporarily waives in-person home visit to enroll and permits telephone/telehealth visits as an alternative.



### 3. CARES Act for VA COVID-19 response:

✓ Requires VA to provide personal protective equipment to VA and community-based workers that provide care to veterans in their home.



### 3. CARES Act for VA COVID-19 response:

✓ Ensures the 2020 Economic Impact
Payments veterans receive under the
CARES Act shall not be treated as income to
avoid a loss or reduction of *any* VA benefit.



### 3. CARES Act for VA COVID-19 response:

✓ Increases flexibility for vulnerable veterans with limb loss, allowing them to seek prosthetic assistance at community providers instead of VA.

- ✓ EHR timeline uncertain

- ✓ Debt Management Center
  - DMC suspend debt collections on NEW debts
  - Request waiver of debt collections for existing debts-COVID-19 related

### **COVID-19 Impact on Claims and Benefits**

- ✓ Date of Receipt Issues
  - VA will accept "post mark" as date of receipt
  - Federal Register will publish rule change



## Shane Liermann, Deputy for Benefits COVID-19 Impact on Claims and Benefits

- ✓ Time Sensitive forms/claims
  - After time limit has expired, must file form with a separate note that this is late due to COVID-19 and requesting waiver



## Shane Liermann, Deputy for Benefits COVID-19 Impact on Claims and Benefits

- ✓ VA C&P Exams
  - Cancelling all in-person exams—will not rate cases based on veterans not appearing to exams during this time
  - Contract Exam Office-Possible Teleexams with vendors



## Shane Liermann, Deputy for Benefits COVID-19 Impact on Claims and Benefits

- Hearings
  - Cancelled Board of Veterans Appeals
    - Increase Tele-hearings
  - DROs—tele-hearings
    - Informal or Formal

### **Education Legislation**

✓ S. 3503, Stand alone legislation that was introduced on March 16<sup>th</sup> and became Public-Law 116-128 on March 21<sup>st</sup>.

## Jeremy Villanueva, Assistant Legislative Director S.3503

✓ This bill authorizes the VA to keep the housing allowance the same for those who were forced to start distance learning due to the COVID pandemic.

✓ Good through December 21, 2020



# Jeremy Villanueva, Assistant Legislative Director HR 6322, the "Student Veteran Coronavirus Response Act of 2020"

Extends the timelines for those who are utilizing VA education benefits and are currently enrolled in courses through the Coronavirus pandemic



# Jeremy Villanueva, Assistant Legislative Director HR 6322, the "Student Veteran Coronavirus Response Act of 2020"

✓ Passed by the House March 31

Recently failed UC in the Senate



## Jeremy Villanueva, Assistant Legislative Director CARES Act/3rd COVID-19 Package

- ✓ Paycheck Protection Program
  - Makes available low interest loans to small businesses



## Jeremy Villanueva, Assistant Legislative Director CARES Act/3rd COVID-19 Package

- ✓ Paycheck Protection Program
  - Loan can be forgiven for expenses used to pay for mortgage payments, payroll costs, etc. as long as the business does not change their payroll before June 30, 2020.



## Jeremy Villanueva, Assistant Legislative Director CARES Act/3rd COVID-19 Package

- ✓ Paycheck Protection Program
  - Some problems during roll out

- √ 4<sup>th</sup> COVID-19 Package
  - Looking to have a \$250 billion plus up for Payroll Protection program.
