Later in 2005, he redeployed to Ramadi, Iraq as a member of 3rd Battalion, 7th Marine Regiment. He returned from the war in 2006 and was honorably discharged.

Before being appointed associate national communications director in 2022, he advocated on behalf of veterans in the areas of education, employment, housing, healthcare, and veterans benefits through Swords to Plowshares and the National Coalition for Homeless Veterans.

He is a life member and chapter commander of DAV Chapter 4 in Maryland, and has earned a master's of public administration degree from San Francisco State University and a bachelor's degree from Cal Poly Humboldt. Miller and his wife, Libby, reside in Silver Spring, Maryland, with their two dogs.

I am excited to see Kevin continue on the path to success as a valued member of the DAV family. I am confident that he will continue to bring great value to our communications department and help DAV reach more veterans, their families and the American public.
