With the concurrence of National Commander Daniel Contreras, I am pleased to announce the appointment of Andrew Clark, a national area supervisor and national service office supervisor, to the role of assistant national service director at DAV Washington Headquarters effective May 15, 2025.

In this capacity, Clark will support DAV efforts and provide oversight to veterans and their families accessing VA benefits and services, including claims, appeals and transition support.

Clark, a native of Black River, New York, enlisted in the Air Force in 2001 and served until 2014, when he was medically retired. He achieved the rank of master sergeant. Clark served as a jet mechanic, and his military career included deployments to Israel and the United Arab Emirates, with additional service in England and South Korea.

He began his DAV career in 2016 as a national service officer apprentice in San Antonio. In 2017, he was promoted to associate national service officer in San Antonio before becoming the national service office assistant supervisor in Phoenix in 2020. He was then promoted to national service office supervisor in Muskogee, Oklahoma, in 2021. In 2023, Clark was promoted to national area supervisor for Area 12 out of Muskogee.

Clark is a life member of Chapter 88 in Coweta, Oklahoma. He earned a bachelor's degree in business management and a master's in management from American Military University.

We are thrilled to have Andrew join DAV's national staff. He is a capable and proven leader and a committed advocate for veterans, their families, caregivers and survivors. Commander Contreras and I are fully confident that he will continue to help ensure that we keep our promise to America's veterans.
