In this capacity, Clark will support DAV efforts and provide oversight to veterans and their families accessing VA benefits and services, including claims, appeals and transition support.

Clark, a native of Black River, New York, enlisted in the Air Force in 2001 and served until 2014, when he was medically retired. He achieved the rank of master sergeant. He was then promoted to national service office supervisor in Muskogee, Oklahoma, in 2021. In 2023, Clark was promoted to national area supervisor for Area 12 out of Muskogee.

Clark is a life member of Chapter 88 in Coweta, Oklahoma. He earned a bachelor's degree in business management and a master's in management from American Military University.

We are thrilled to have Andrew join DAV's national staff. He is a capable and proven leader and a committed advocate for veterans, their families, caregivers and survivors. Commander Contreras and I are fully confident that he will continue to help ensure that we keep our promise to America's veterans.
