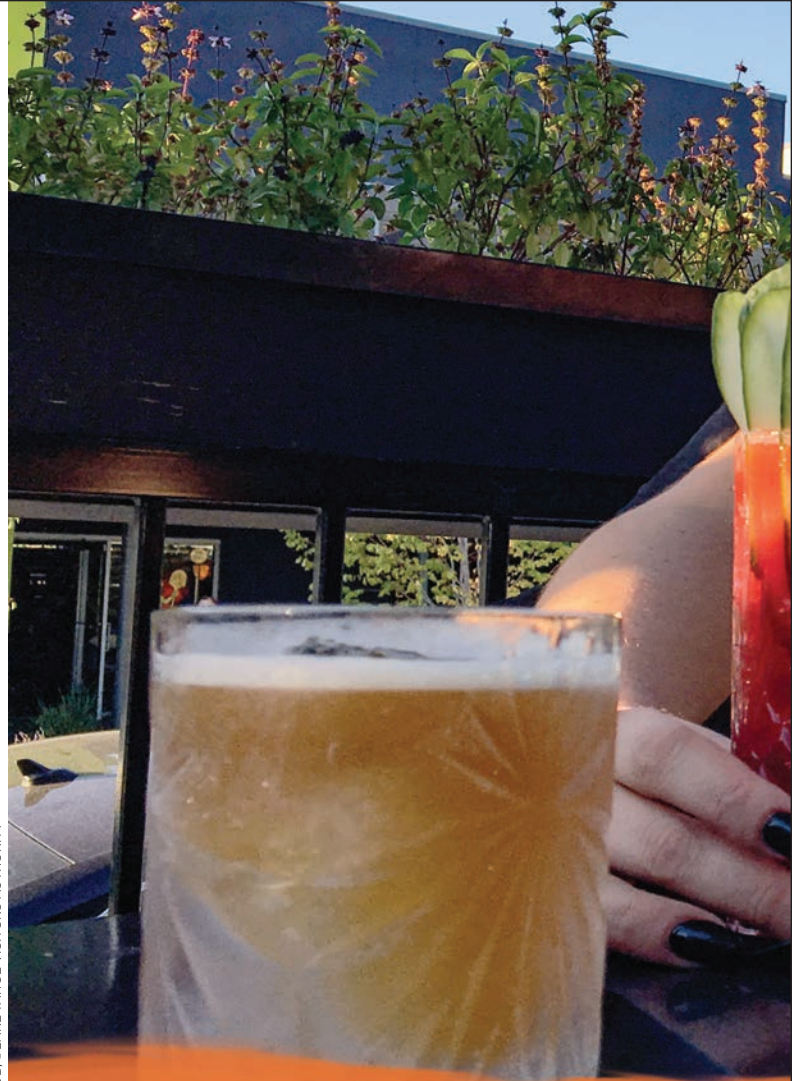

There's always an amazing new exhibit showcased at the acclaimed Nevada Museum of Art, ranging from American Impressionism to works by Nevada artists and more. Best of all, it's a quick stroll from downtown. Or check out the National Automobile Museum — also just a short walk away — home to one of the most prestigious car collections in the entire world.

Experience the talents of the Reno Philharmonic, Nevada Opera and Reno Chamber Orchestra. Gather the family and head to the Terry Lee Wells Nevada Discovery Museum. Or hit the beach for the unforgettable Lake Tahoe Shakespeare Festival.

And don't forget the coolest party on the planet, Burning Man. Once a year, nearly 70,000 participants gather to be part of an experimental community — Black Rock City — in Nevada's Black Rock Desert just north of Reno for this event filled with art cars, fire dancers, themed camps and original art on an epic scale.

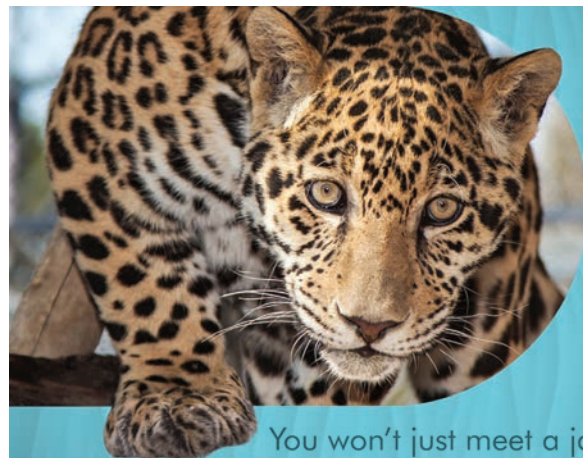

Into the Blue

Mark Twain called Lake Tahoe “the fairest picture the whole world affords,” and many think of it as America’s most beautiful drive. You can begin your journey anywhere along the loop, but you might want to start by heading up the switchbacks of Mt. Rose Highway (SR 431), where just past the summit on the way to Incline Village is one of the region’s best overlooks. From there, head west to Tahoe City’s Fanny Bridge, the Gatekeeper’s Museum and the best lazy-day river rafting around. Continue south past Emerald Bay, where you can hike or simply enjoy the breathtaking view. Then, head to Heavenly Village for shopping, gondola rides or a paddleboat cruise. As you continue north along the eastern shore of the lake, stop at one of the many state parks or take a refreshing swim at Sand Harbor.

TRIP LENGTH: 143 MILES ROUND TRIP



From Reno to Truckee

Take a journey from Reno to Truckee, winding through the beautiful Truckee River canyon, eventually arriving at the quaint California town. In Truckee, you're greeted with dining options that range from upscale fare to hip bistros to bar and grill favorites. Discover one-of-a-kind alpine resort furnishings and apparel, plus shops filled with everything from sweets to toys to cookware to fine art. Drink in the atmosphere as you indulge in a wine tasting in the heart of downtown Truckee. And be sure to set aside time for the captivating museum, views and endless activities that await you at nearby Donner Lake and Donner Memorial State Park.

TRIP LENGTH: 69 MILES ROUND TRIP





Cool in the City

Every city has a few places that refuse to blend in — like Reno’s Riverwalk and MidTown districts. You never know what you’ll discover in the shops, galleries, coffeehouses, museums and restaurants that line the river and the South Virginia neighborhoods. Start your walking tour at the Visitor Center ¹, photobomb the Reno Arch ¹, cruise the “streets” at one of the top five car collections at the National Automobile Museum ², explore the Terry Lee Wells Nevada Discovery Museum ³ and then head south a few blocks to the MidTown District ⁴, Reno’s emerging cultural hot spot peppered with funky eateries and stylish taverns. Next, visit the Nevada Museum of Art ⁵, check out the Truckee River Whitewater Park ⁶, and find yourself a place to relax and partake in a meal along the Riverwalk ⁷.

TRIP LENGTH: 2.5 MILE WALKING TOUR





The Wild, Wild West

Virginia City wasn't always the small, ruggedly charming place it is today. In its heyday, it was the largest city between San Francisco and Denver. Sample its charms by cruising the boardwalk, taking a ghost tour, visiting the historic Fourth Ward School Museum and ambling through the Comstock Wild Horse and Mining Museum. Take a scenic drive to Carson City, the capital of the Silver State and home to the Nevada State Museum. Enjoy a stroll along the Kit Carson Trail and explore Carson City's landmarks and stately Victorian houses. Be sure to check out the Nevada State Railroad Museum, the Governor's Mansion and the Capitol. For a truly unique experience, ride the rails on the historic V&T Railroad which runs daily between Carson City and Virginia City.

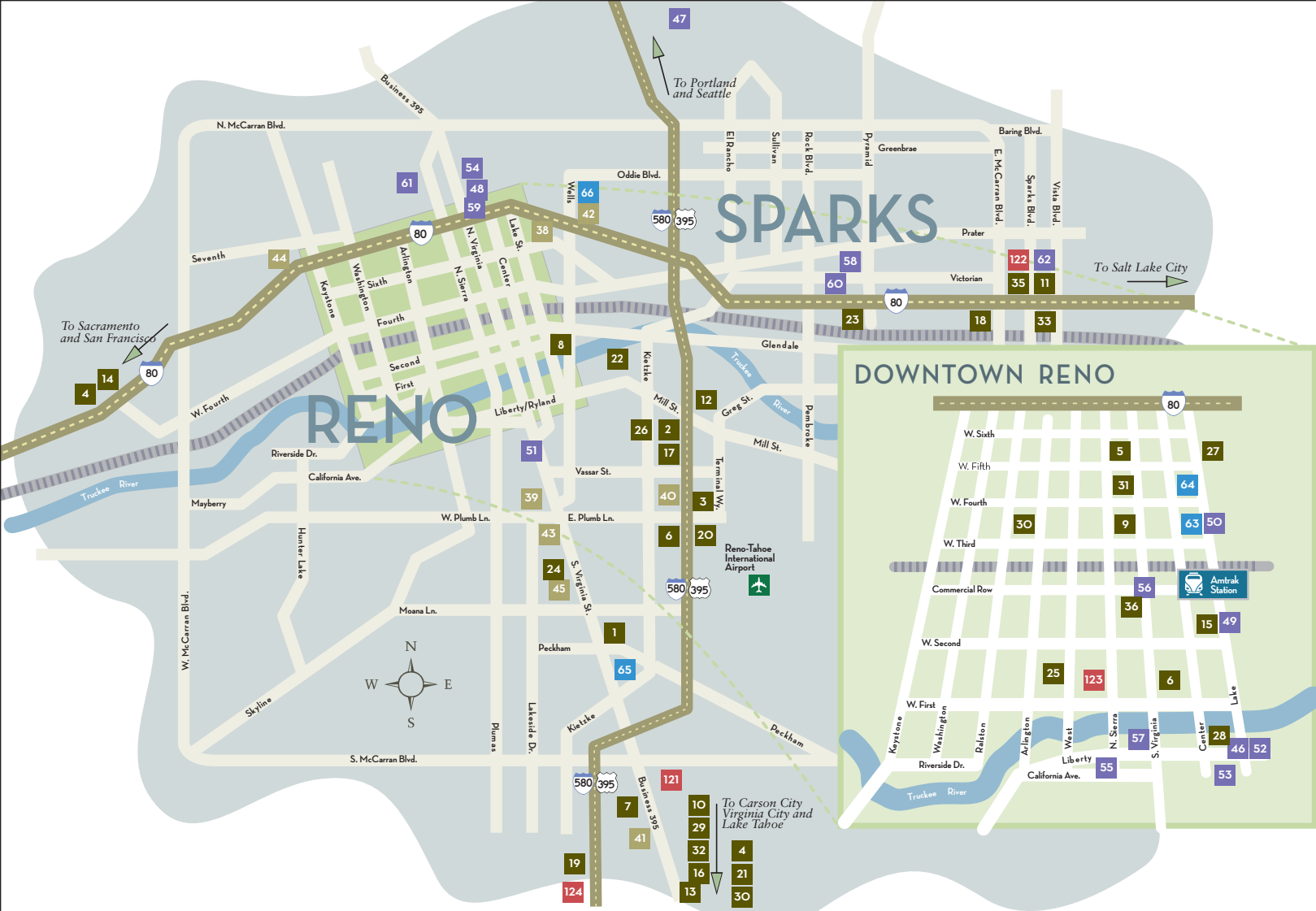

Reasons to start packing

Getting here is easier than you think! Several direct flights are available from all parts of the country, including the Midwest and the East Coast. Check out a list of airlines serving Reno-Tahoe International Airport by going to VisitRenoTahoe.com.

If you're hitting the road to get here, Reno and Sparks are located at the junction of Interstate 80 and U.S. 395/I-580. I-80 provides all-weather access across Donner Summit from Central and Northern California. From Southern California, it's a straight shot up U.S. 395 along the dramatic eastern front of the Sierra Nevada. From the Northwest, take I-5 south to I-80 or, in the spring and summer, opt for the scenic shortcut that leaves I-5 at Mount Shasta and follows California 89 and 44 southeast through Susanville.

A third option is Amtrak's California Zephyr, which arrives daily from the Bay Area and Sacramento to the west and Salt Lake City and Denver to the east. Trains from the Northwest, coastal Southern California and the Central Valley connect to the Zephyr in Sacramento.

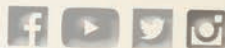
